Treasure Hunting inside the School Library

On November 20 participants will find the first clue of the Treasure Hunting on the school website, on the library fb page, and on the library commons board. From that moment the hunting of **six mysterious library books** will start.

Library opening hours for the hunting: every day from 9 a.m. except Wednesday and Saturday.

After receiving from the librarian some instructions about how books are ordered in the library (CDD System), teams will have to find the first mysterious book and then one by one all the others.

In each retrieved book participants will find a clue to the next one.

As soon as they find a book Team Captains are requested to email the book Author, Title, and Publisher to the email library address <u>bibliotecastein@gmail.com</u>

If necessary Team Captains might ask for some help and will be allowed to share a drive folder with the clue help. Of course this will imply a penalty!
